Sakhi's Impact In 2024

This year, Sakhi's programs have achieved unprecedented milestones, creating transformative impacts in the lives of survivors. By the end of this year, **we will work with over 600 survivors--the highest number to date.** Our holistic programs supported their journeys to safety through crisis management, mental health counseling, legal services, and access to essentials such as food, housing, and economic security.

Survivor-led

100%

of survivors working with our Counseling Program achieved at least one selfactualized goal within six months of working with Sakhi. 95% of survivors working with our Anti-Violence Program gained safety from harm within this same period of time.

Housing justice is fundamental to healing

90%

of survivors who successfully exited our Housing Program after receiving rental assistance **retained stable**, **permanent housing** and self-reported feeling more empowered compared to when they started working with Sakhi. Sakhi's Housing Justice Program **distributed over \$1.2 million this year**--the highest amount to date--providing critical support to **239 survivors**, **a 19% increase** from 2023.

Economic justice is Survivor Justice

93%

of survivors accessed tools and resources towards to be emotional and financial self-sufficiency. 42% sought assistance with advancing their educational goals, 45% were connected to education towards long term career advancement, and 88% of survivors in the program successfully secured public benefits, providing them with critical support on their path to stability and independence.

Youth justice for the future

94%

more Youth Empowerment Program participants worked with Sakhi compared to 2023. Sakhi works with survivors starting at the age of six, and is committed to uplifting and mobilizing youth survivor justice.
